 and you are welcome to join me in supporting this VERY important organization or
 name an organization of your choosing.
- Please provide a link to your work (website) or a few samples of your work so that we
 can understand your creative vision and help plan the limited space accordingly.
 Expo will be limited to 15 artists/exhibitors to ensure proper space for all to enjoy.
 Deadline for Expo submissions is May 15, 2025, or when all spaces are taken.
 Acceptance for exhibitors is first come first serve.
- For accepted Expo artists, please prepare a short written statement about you and/or your artwork. This is your time to shine and showcase you and your work to a broader audience. An artist's statement or statement on your current work will help you connect with the audience and Expo attendees.
- This is a Pride Month Art Expo and is intended to showcase love and support for the LGBTQ+ community. Open to all allies/members of the community. Be respectful.
